
## We hope you enjoy our Aylesbury Key Worker Duck Trail – here's just a little bit about the reasons behind the trail.

Aylesbury is renowned for being home to a breed of domesticated duck, bred mainly for meat and its appearance. It's a large duck with pure white plumage, a pink bill, orange legs and feet, an unusually large keel, and a horizontal stance with its body parallel to the ground. The precise origins of the breed are unclear, but raising white ducks became very popular around the area, with many farms breeding this specific bird, which lead to the naming of the breed **Aylesbury Duck**.

2020 has been a unique year for us all. We've witnessed many things that didn't seem possible just 12 months ago, from a shortage of toilet roll and queuing outside supermarkets to getting used to the new "normal" of wearing face masks and greeting each other with an elbow rather than a handshake or hug.
